

What to expect

- The ministry is about strengthening, encouraging, and comforting.
- A group member will be invited to the Ministry seat.
- We'll lay hands on the person receiving ministry.
- If they're not comfortable with laying on of hands, speak up.
- We may take a minute to hear what the Lord is saying.
- We'll share His heart.
- We won't interpret or extrapolate.
- When done, we'll pray over the person and move on to the next.

How to act during ministry

- If there are other groups in the room, be aware of it and please keep the volume down.
- The person in the Ministry seat should record the session on their phone for review and protection.
- We don't allow others to record unless the person being ministered to doesn't have a recording device.
- Keep their eyes closed to be free from distraction.
- If the word they receive seems wrong or inappropriate, just let it go.
- If the word doesn't make sense, shelve it and pray about it.
- If the word makes sense, seek the Lord on what to do with it.
- Others in the group should
 - Remain in prayer for the person receiving ministry.
 - Remain engaged and quiet so as not to distract.
 - If they hear a word that applies to them, take it as their own.
- If someone in the group thinks they're getting a word from the Holy Spirit, please keep it to yourself and share it another time in another setting. For clarity and flow of the Holy Spirit, we ask that only the Prophetic Team members give words.

After ministry

- Brief constructive feedback (1-2 minutes each depending on time constraints).
- Keep feedback related to the ministry time.
- If the Team leader cuts you short, don't be offended, we must live inside the boundaries that have been set for us.
- Encourage them to transcribe their words so they can reference them easily.
- Clear the room quietly and quickly so we can prep for the next group.
